Chilean



- **Emiliana Sauvignon Blanc, Bio Bio Valley 2010** €20.45
 Fresh aromas of citrus fruits with herbal and mineral notes. Brisk, lively acidity heightens the pleasingly soft citrus finish. Glass €5.50



- **Emiliana Cabernet Sauvignon, Rapel Valley 2009** €20.45
 Lots of typical Chilean Cabernet varietal character, quite soft and fruity but with some depth and structure; lightly dry tannins complete the finish. Glass €5.50

French



- **Croix des Vents Chardonnay, Vin de Pays d'Oc, Languedoc 2009** €20.45
 Bright, pale and very clean. Nose is fruity, with some smoky taste. Mouth is rich and full bodied with a long elegant finish. Glass €5.50



- **Croix des Vents Merlot, Vin de Pays d'Oc, Languedoc 2009** €20.45
 Colour is ruby red with purple reflects. Nose shows a lot of fruit, red berries. The structure is intense but not aggressive, length is impressive. Glass €5.50

FRANCE



- **Château de Parenchère Bordeaux Blanc Sec 2008** €26.50
 Well balanced and very aromatic dry white. Displays intense white and citrus fruit aromas: fresh and round on the palate.



- **Touraine Sauvignon, Tour de la Roche, Pierre Chainier, Loire 2009** €24.00
 Refreshing with complex, fruity and floral nose, grapefruit and white box aromas: elegant and rich on the palate.



- **Côtes du Rhône, Domaine Boisson 2008** €25.00
 Easy drinking with fruity fragrances of cherry and strawberry. Unpretentious with round and subtle qualities.



- **1749 Rosé d'Anjou, Pierre Chainier, Loire 2009** €23.50
 Very aromatic semi-dry Rosé; rounded and refreshing, aromas of strawberry and peach: elegant and well balanced.

ITALY



- **Pinot Grigio Sant'Elisa, Banear, Friuli 2009** €22.50
A delicate and persistent bouquet, nice and fruity with notes of pear, apple, citrus and flowers. Palate is light, dry and smooth with a long aftertaste. Glass €6.00



- **Cetamura Chianti, Badia a Coltibuono, Tuscany 2008/09** €27.00
Full, well balanced, soft but tasty with good structure. Pleasant acidity with clean and persistent aftertaste.

SPAIN



- **La Báscula, Turret Fields, Monastrell/Syrah, Jumilla 2008** €25.50
Spicy, berry laden, plump black fruits with a delicious long, smooth finish. A wine which has clearly had the sun on its back.

AUSTRALIA



- **Stonefish Chardonnay, NSW 2009** €22.00
Melon fruit nose, soft and balanced fruit palate with rich flavour and oak complexity.



- **Stonefish Shiraz, NSW 2009** €22.00
Rich, ripe palate with red berries interwoven with oak. Medium bodied wine enhanced by soft tannins. Glass €6.00

NEW ZEALAND



- **Sherwood Estate Sauvignon Blanc, Marlborough 2009** €26.00
Fresh, lively gooseberry and passion fruit aromas with a touch of cut grass on the nose. Rich, concentrated palate with beautiful, balanced finish.

ARGENTINA



- **Renacer Punto Final Malbec Classico, Mendoza 2009** €25.00
The colour gives away the power of this wine. Modern up-front fruit – fully ripened and beautifully structured.

SPARKLING WINE



- **Prosecco, Coldigiano, Veneto NV** €27.00
A Spumante out of the top drawer. Fresh, crisp palate with tremendously well balanced citric fruit leading to lingering finish.

CHAMPAGNE



- **Lanson Black Label Brut NV** €65.00
